

COVID-19 - the resumption of business travel

The return of domestic travel is already well under way, but international travel will be slower to resume

Travelers told us when they expected to resume regular business travel

- Domestic travel has resumed more quickly than international, with 34% of travelers already making domestic trips, compared to 14% for international.
- By the end of 2021, 81% of travelers expect to be regularly making domestic trips, compared to 44% for international travel.
- Travel restrictions are likely to be as much of a factor as intent in delaying the resumption of international business trips.
- International trips should pick up momentum during the final quarter of 2021, accelerating in Q1 2022.
